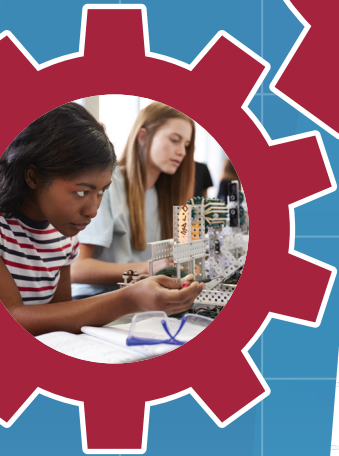


# THIS IS HOW I #STEMINWV
