**WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT
HIGH SCHOOL RESOURCE**
The Skills to Succeed (S2S) Academy was developed through Accenture's Corporate Citizenship program and is available free of charge to TSA advisors and chapter members. The S2S Academy features an engaging multimedia interface, which delivers 36 online courses and activities (30 to 50 minute modules) that focus on three topic areas:

- Choosing a career (Choose A Career)
- Interview techniques (Getting A Job)
- Success in the workplace (Success at Work)

The courses can be included in a traditional or virtual classroom environment directed by an advisor, or student members can access and complete courses on their own. The S2S Academy content is appropriate for high school students, with some modules applicable to middle school learners. Users are able to select online modules based on their interests and goals. Once a student selects a topic area (see bullets above), the academy provides recommended modules within that area. Users can change or add to their interest area and receive additional module recommendations. The S2S Academy website also tracks student progress. Both student members and advisors access the content with a registration code specifically distributed to TSA participants.

Middle school chapter members and advisors can access career exploration information and activities developed through collaboration between the U.S. Department of Labor and Scholastic. Exploration materials introduce middle school students, parents, and teachers to ideas for careers and apprenticeships, based on student interest, and can be found on the Apprenticeship.gov website. Access to career activities for students can be found on Scholastic's apprenticeship webpage. These resources are available free of charge to TSA advisors and chapter members
