



Most Outstanding Member Scholarship

This scholarship is meant to incentivize and reward excellence in Level 2 Technology Student Association (TSA) events. The scoring criteria is listed below. The award will be given to the applicant with the highest point total. In the event of a tie, the West Virginia TSA Advisory Committee will determine the winner based off of the full application of the tied applicants.

Eligibility: Applicant must be a current WV TSA member. Applicant must have been a member for at least 11th and 12th grade years. Applicant must submit evidence of acceptance into a STEM program at a higher education institution in West Virginia. Award may be used at either a two-year or four-year institution. STEM program can include STEM-adjacent (STEM teacher, Business to open a technology firm, etc.)

Award: The awardee of the one-time scholarship will be announced at the Annual Spring Conference during the Awards Ceremony. Scholarship amount is \$1000 and will be paid directly to the educational institution to pay for tuition, room & board, and/or other expenses necessary to education.

Application Process: Application must be postmarked by February 14th. Point totals will be tallied prior to the Spring Conference. 12th grade state awards will be added and considered for the scholarship. The 12th grade national conference competitions do not qualify. The awardee will receive the one-time scholarship at the Annual Spring Conference during the Awards Ceremony.

Selection Criteria: Applicant with the highest total points from Level 2 (High School) events will be awarded the scholarship. The scale is below. National points are in addition to state points. National points do not stack through progression. The highest point total achieved at nationals qualifies. (State 1st Place 30 + National Finalist 10 = 40 points) (State 1st Place 30 + National Champion 100 = 130)

State 3rd Place – 10 points

State 2nd Place – 20 points

State 1st Place – 30 points

National Semi-Finalist – 10 points (announced top 24)

National Finalist - 20 points (announced top 12)

National Top 3 – 50 points

National Champion – 100 points

*National Technical Honor Society – 30 points

*National Achievement - 30 points (bronze, silver, gold - need to level up 10, 20, 30)
