



## Model Citizen Scholarship

This scholarship is meant to award a member who has significant leadership and volunteer experience in Technology Student Association (TSA), other organizations, and the community.

**Eligibility:** Applicant must be a current WV TSA member. Applicant must have been a member for at least 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> grade years. Applicant must demonstrate leadership capabilities and a passion for TSA. Applicant must submit evidence of acceptance into a higher education institution in West Virginia. Award may be used at either a two-year or four-year institution.

**Award:** The awardee of the one-time scholarship will be announced at the Annual Spring Conference during the Awards Ceremony. Scholarship amount is \$1000 and will be paid directly to the educational institution to pay for tuition, room & board, and/or other expenses necessary to education.

**Application Process:** Application must be postmarked to WV TSA by February 14<sup>th</sup>. The West Virginia TSA Advisory Committee will notify finalists and schedule interviews by March 1<sup>st</sup>. The awardee will receive the one-time scholarship at the Annual Spring Conference during the Awards Ceremony.
